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Stevens Pavilion - Project of the Week

Stevens Pavilion, a \$13.8 million medical office building on the campus of Stevens Hospital in Edmonds, opened in August. The 80,000-square-foot facility, at 21601 76th Ave. W., combines physician offices and outpatient services.

A skylit atrium and centralized waiting area are centerpieces of the three-story building.

The hospital's sleep center has expanded from two beds to six in the new facility, and the imaging services department has been revamped. The department now offers three mammography suites, an ultrasound room and a stereotactic biopsy room to provide patients an alternative to surgery.

The rooms feature walls adorned with art and windows with territorial views.

The mix of tenants in the building includes Stevens Pavilion Imaging, Stevens Sleep Center, Edmonds Center for Outpatient Surgery, Stevens Pavilion Laboratory, Stevens Center for Internal Medicine, Stevens Cardiology Group, Stevens Orthopedic Group, Puget Sound Neurology, Blue Mountain Home Medical Supply, Hadfield's Pharmacy and pulmonologists Dr. Robert Cox and Dr. Robert McCoy.

About 9,000 square feet of unleased space remains.
